- 1. Using one of the resources listed on the resource page or your Bible's concordance, pick one or two attributes of God to study.
 - A) Define the attribute.
 - B) In your own words, how would you describe this attribute to a Christian sister?
 - C) What about this attribute causes you to understand and know God better?
 - D) Which Scriptures tell us about this attribute of God?
 - E) Is this attribute "incommunicable" (those that God does not share or communicate to anyone or anything else), or is it "communicable" (those that He shares with other beings)? If it is communicable, do you see this attribute in yourself?
- 2. Write out the lyrics of a praise hymn, song or psalm that speaks to your heart.
 - A) What do these lyrics tell you about God?
 - B) What do these lyrics tell you about yourself or mankind?
 - C) Look up Scripture references that support these lyrics (if you can't find any support in the Bible, it may not be an appropriate song of praise).
 - D) Sing or read these lyrics out loud at least three times in the next week.
- 3. Read in New Morning Mercies.

A) Pick one devotion from the last week that speaks to your condition.

- B) What, if anything, about this devotion convicted you? What might you need to change as a response to this devotion?
- C) Share this devotion with someone either as an encouragement to them, or to ask them to pray for you concerning the devotion.
- D) Read the Scripture at the bottom of the devotion. Why did Tripp direct you to that Scripture?
