Week 3 Study Questions- Jesus Suffered for our Forgiveness

1 Peter 3:18 reads "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God." We should have a greater desire to obey the commands of God when we consider the immense forgiveness He has given us and the high cost at which it came.
