Compassion International

In the fall of 1952, Rev. Everett Swanson flew from Chicago to South Korea to minister to American troops fighting in the Korean War. During his time there, he grew increasingly troubled by the sight of hundreds of war orphans living on the streets, where many died of starvation, exposure, and disease.

Broken by the plight of these children, Swanson was faced with a question: "What are you going to do?" His answer to these six little words led to the organization now known as Compassion International. More than 70 years later, Compassion reaches over two million children around the world through its child development program – providing education, health care, nutrition, clean water, vocational training, Christian instruction, mentorship, recreational activities, and more.
