Awa was registered at the Compassion center, and has been receiving medical care and ointment against dermatosis, a skin disease that took the lives of her two older siblings.

Awa began to grow up strong, and she also received help with school fees, health checkups, food packages and more. Her sponsors began sending additional gifts that drastically improved her family's life.

Awa no longer has to walk four miles daily to school or the Compassion center because she received a bicycle as one of her sponsors' gifts. She is able to carry her brother, Ibrahim, on the back of the bike.

Her sponsors blessed her family with another gift that enabled Awa's family to become livestock owners for the first time. Cows are the greatest treasure for families in Awa's tribe. Owning cows is like having gold. The income their animals provide allows Awa's family to afford two daily meals and keep some millet in storage.
