The Master’s Academy Int’l (TMAI)—Myanmar

A local TMAI team member shared this about Myanmar. "Our city Yangon was fine. We felt the earthquake very strong. So far, there are no damages in Yangon, but Mandalay, the second largest city, was hit very badly. Many buildings were destroyed. The death toll is expected to be over 2,000, with many more injured.

Please continue to pray for Myanmar. It is very difficult for the people as the country is already suffering from the civil war." Please pray:

- That the Lord would use this disaster to draw His people to Himself.
- That the Lord would equip the church in Myanmar to serve those who have been affected, both spiritually and physically.
